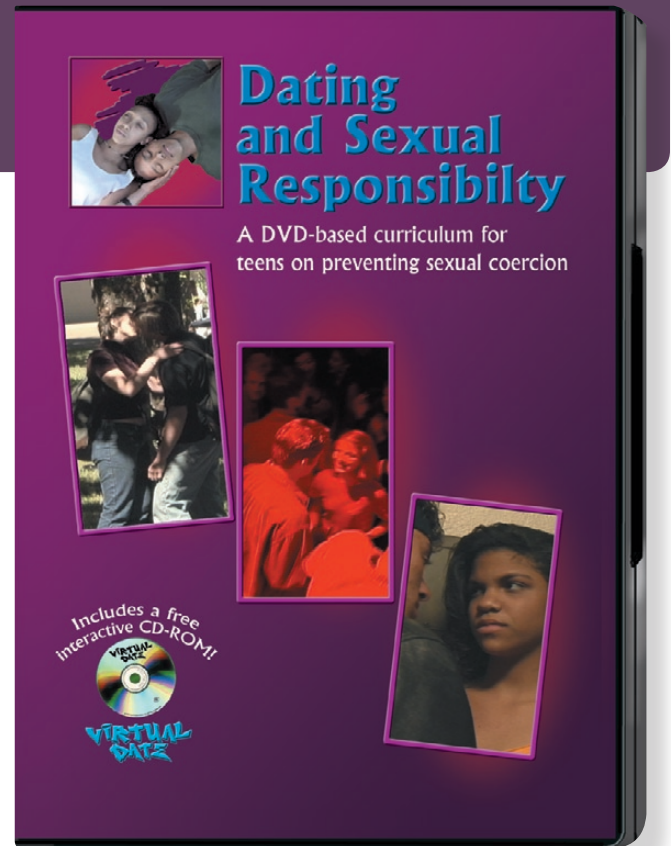
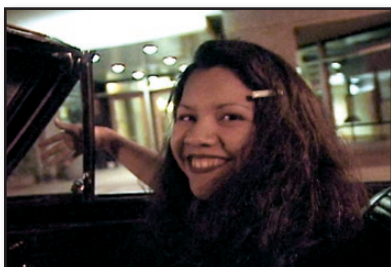
Unit Three: Refusals and Responses. The purpose of this unit is to build positive social skills for refusing sexual advances and responding to refusals.
