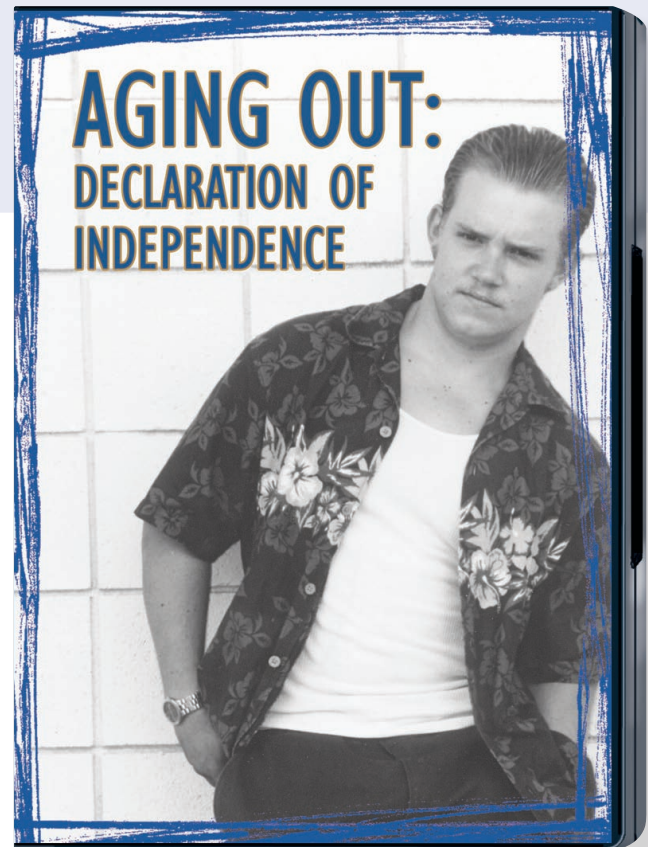
David Griffin has been in more than 20 foster care placements. Leaving the system at 18, he went on a self-destructive drug and crime binge, coped with homelessness and incarceration, and eventually left California with the hope of becoming a fisherman in Alaska.

Declaration of Independence is part of two-time Academy Award-nominee and Emmy winner Roger Weisberg's powerful documentary series *Aging Out*, which follows five young people as they fend for themselves after being discharged from foster care. Winner of seven awards in 2004, including Best Documentary (Golden Reel Award) at the Tiburon Film Festival and Best Documentary at the Reel to Reel Festival in Charlotte, NC. *Declaration of Independence* aired on PBS in 2005.
