Viewers learn to:

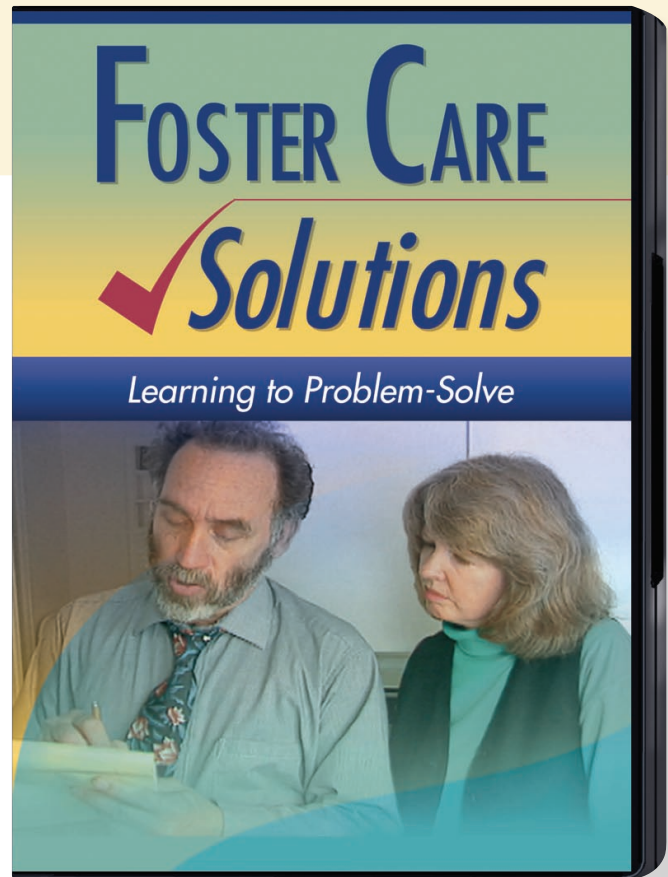
- Identify the problem
