

# Foster Parents Working with Birth Parents

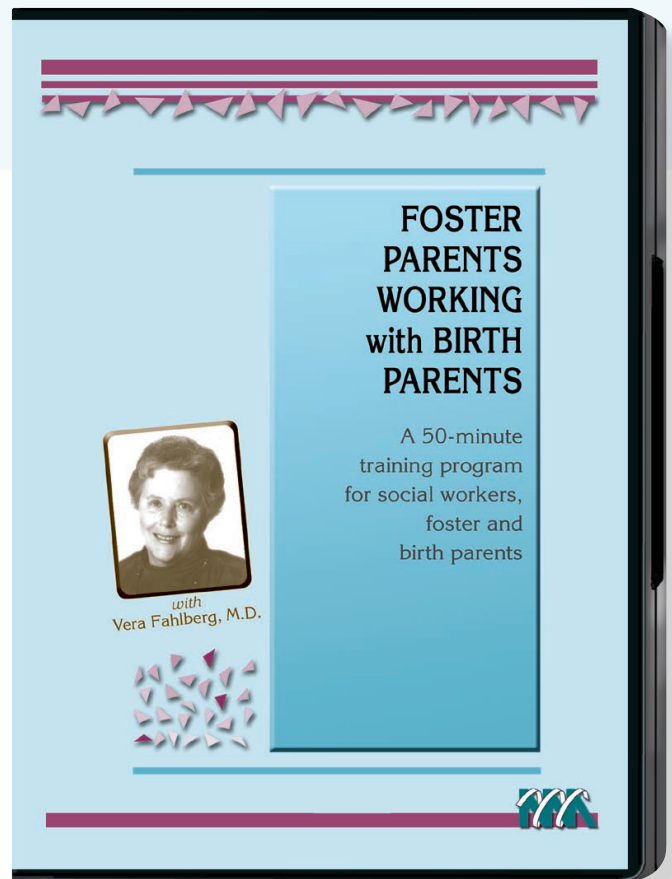
