

# Listening to Birth Families: Forming Kinship Groups

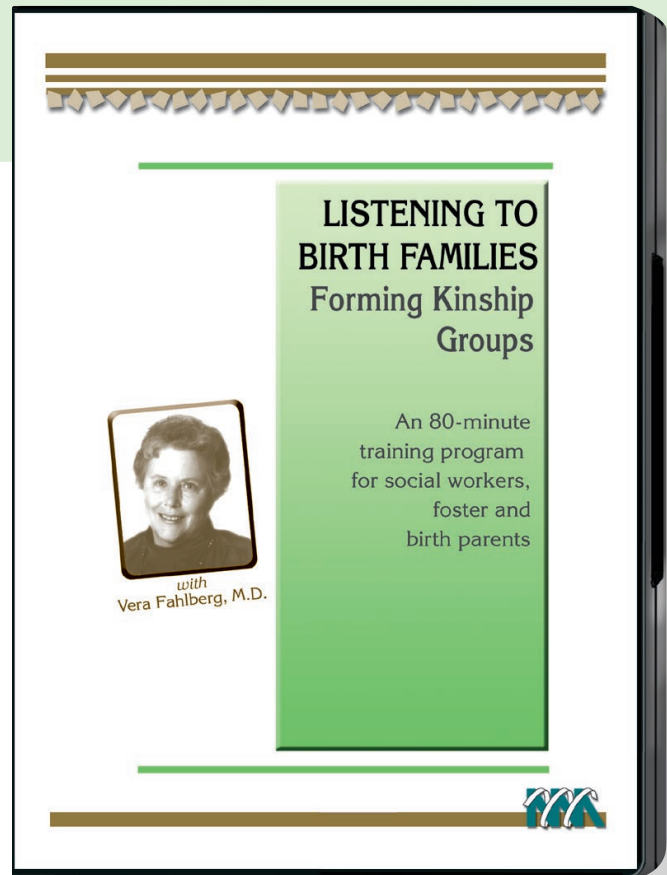
