

Aging Out: With No Direction Home Part of the Aging Out DVD Series

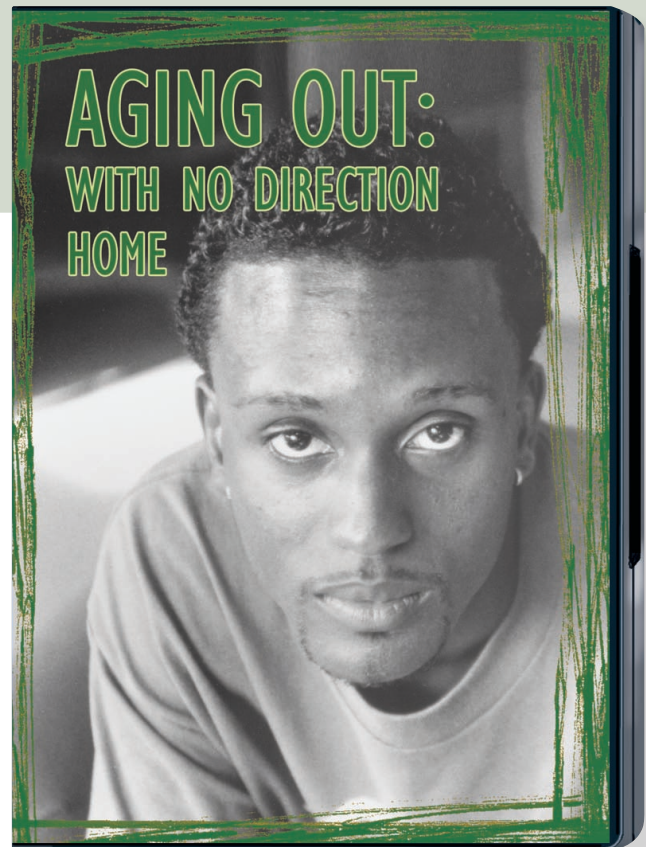
