*Private Lives* is an animated drama about six teens who are training to become peer sex educators. As they learn about sexuality and preventing sexually transmitted diseases, the lessons are made personal by the situations they face outside the classroom.

Visually animated and verbally direct, it presents methods of prevention and workable solutions. Hip condom “commercials” make you laugh but make strong, valid points. Ultimately, these brave, thoughtful teens understand that everyone is vulnerable to STIs and HIV and that education is the first tool in the line of defense.

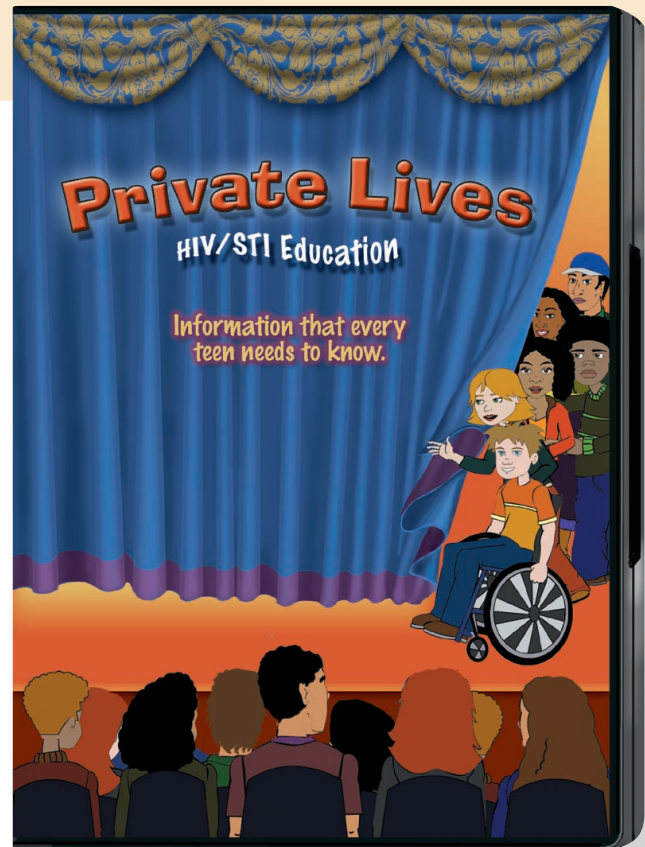


Anessa goes to the doctor because she suspects she has genital warts.
