Disk 1, *Managing Sexual Acting-Out Behaviors*, provides specific techniques for dealing with sexual acting out.

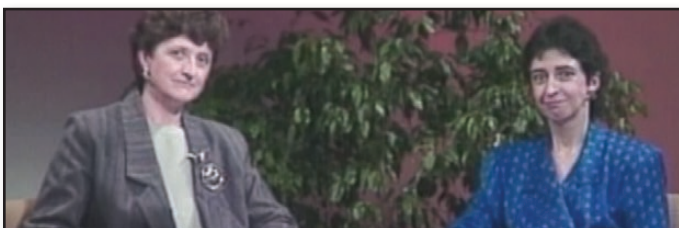
Disk 2, *Understanding and Dealing with Anger*, offers insights from children as they describe their passage from birth home to foster care.
