Scenes from Virtual Date:



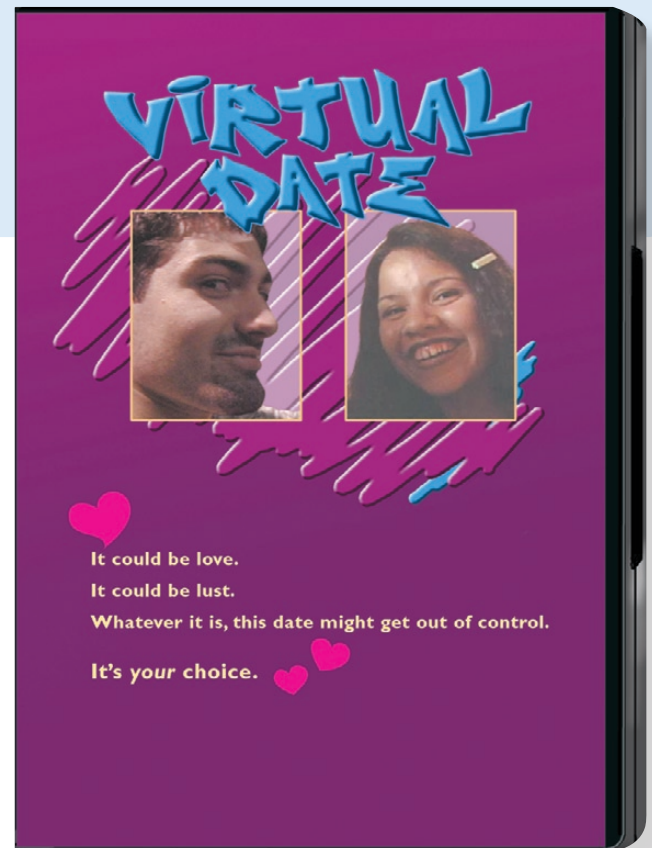
This is the date from Bobby’s point of view – the viewer chooses what Bobby does next and immediately sees her reaction.

If the viewer chooses “Push Her,” Bobby puts more pressure on Kit to kiss.

If the viewer chooses “Go Along,” Bobby agrees with Kit to go inside the dance club.



This is the date from the Kit’s point of view. What will happen next?
